To save the souls of poor sinners, God wishes to establish the devotion to my Immaculate Heart throughout the world.

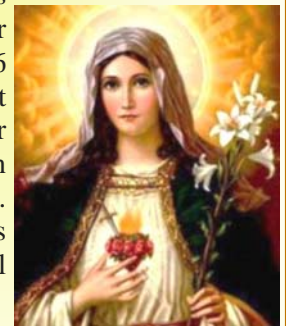
