Pastor's Notes

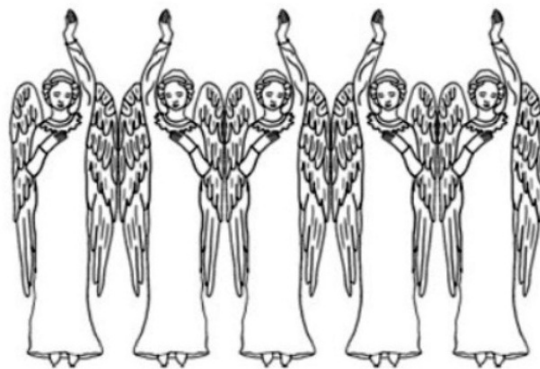
Dear Parishioners:
