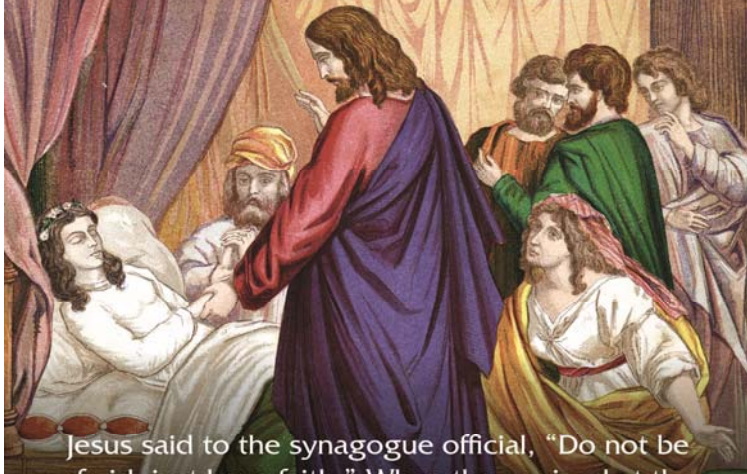


THIRTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

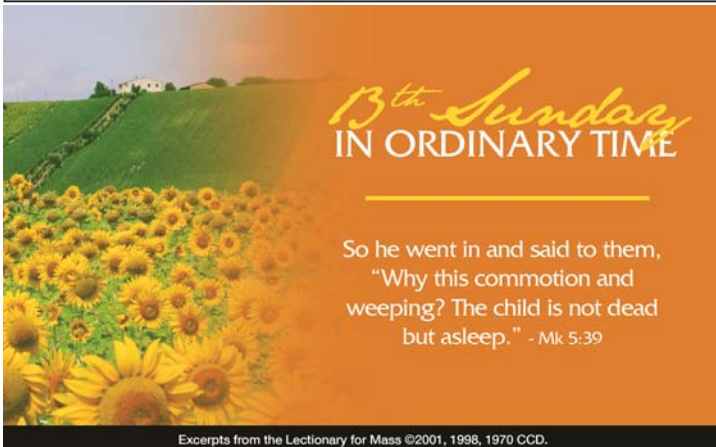
