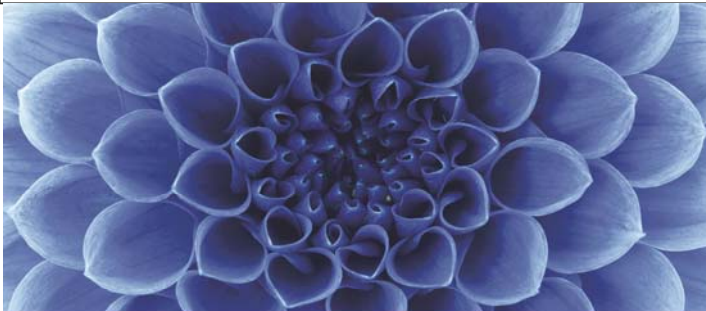

The Apostles' Creed

The Apostle's Creed was used by the Apostles and their followers to evangelize. It lists, in an abbreviated form, what we as Catholics believe. It is the essential of what we believe. The word creed comes from *Credo*, the first word in the Latin original, which means "I believe." It is the first prayer we say when we begin a Rosary. It's a great way to start because the most important truths taught by Jesus: that God is our Creator, and that He is a Trinity of Persons. It summarizes who God is and who we are in relation to Him: His children. It is a powerful prayer because it orients us and reminds us of the truth. If you're a little rusty on it, take the time to pray it and memorize it.

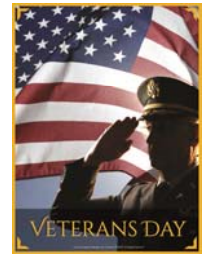
Our Annual October Parish Appeal
